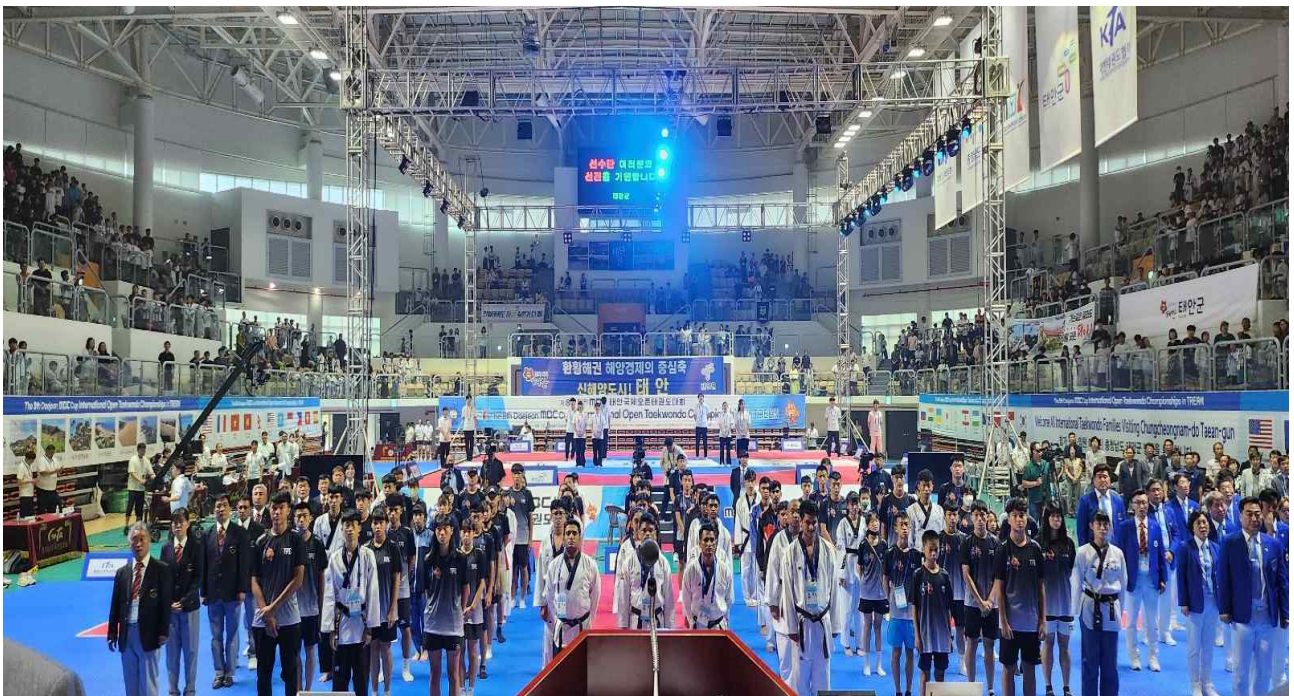

Goal of the Business

- Co-hosted by Chungcheongnam-do Taekwondo Association and Daejeon MBC, the business aims to enhance the status of Republic of Korea and to promote revitalization of taekwondo and it also aims to lead new taekwondo competition culture which is selected by “The Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism as an international competition project for local governments for the second consecutive year”

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KYORUGI

1. Qualification

- 1) Poom or Dan holder certified by Kukkiwon.
- 'City and Province Taekwondo Association registered' Taekwondo Institute participants must participate in sports for all division (B League).
- Athletes registered of KTA 2023~2024 athlete registration must participate in Elite division (A League).
- But, foreign players(color belts) if any B League participants want to participate in A League, he/she can participate without registration of KTA.

2. Classification by division

- 1) Individual
 - A) Children I : Without Distinction of Gender
 - B) Children II : Distinction of A, B League
 - C) Cadet: Distinction of A, B League
 - D) Junior: Distinction of A, B League
 - F) Senior: Distinction of A, B League
- 2) Trio Team : Children II(Mixed Gender), Cadet(Male/Female), Junior(Male/Female), Senior(Male/Female),
 - A) Children II (Without Distinction of Gender and of A, B League possible)
 - B) Cadet, Junior, Senior (With Distinction of Gender and of A, B League)
- 3) Team : Children I(Mixed Gender), Children II(Male/Female), Cadet(Male/Female), Junior(Male/Female), Senior(Male/Female)

3. Method of Competition

- 1) Single elimination tournament system for each division (in the best of three system applied).
- 2) Participants must use officially approved electronic general body protector and headgear.
- 3) Participants must bring their own mandatory general safety equipment (Forearm Guard, Shin Guard, Groin Guard, Torso Guard, Gloves, Mouthpiece, Sensing socks, etc.).
- 4) Participants must wear WT or KTA officially approved gears including Taekwondo uniform(Dobok).
- 5) Competitions shall abide by the WT and KTA Competition Rules & Interpretation.

4. Duration of Competition

- 1) Children II, B League(Children II, Cadet, Junior, Senior): 1 minute / 3 rounds with 30 seconds breaks in between.
- 2) A League(Children II): 1 minute 30 seconds / 3 rounds with 30 seconds breaks in between.
- 3) A League(Cadet, Junior, Senior): 2 minutes / 3 rounds with 1 minute breaks in between.
- 4) Trio Team: competitions will be conducted during a total of 5 minutes and each athlete must play a minimum of 1 minute.or the last 2 minutes, athletes can change each other

after three attacks without the time limit and can play the competition freely. But, competitors must use their right hand when they touch and change the competitor.

(The Defeat on deduction of points will be declared when the deduction of points is over 20 points. Also, victory by margin will be declared when the difference of points between two teams is over 30 points. Last, The competition ends when one team makes 50 points first).

(Details will be decided by the organizing committee meetings)

5. Weigh-In

- 1) Weigh-In of the competitors shall be completed on the previous day of the pertinent competition (15:00~17:00).
 ※Details can be modified in the representatives' meeting.
- 2) During Weigh-In, the male contestant shall wear an underwear, but the female contestant shall wear underpants and a brassiere. However, depending on the condition of a contestant, weigh-in may be conducted in the nude if the contestant wishes to do so.
- 3) Weigh-in shall be made once, however, in case of under or exceeding, one more weigh-in is granted within the time limit to any contestant who did not qualify the first time.

6. Method of Scoring

- 1) Overall results in each division shall be decided by adding up the best results, which are earned by the individual competitor in a team, of each weight division. One gold medal has a bigger score than several silver medals, and, in the same way, one silver medal has a bigger score than several bronze medals. When the overall scores are in a tie, the number of contestants will be a criterion.
 Gold(80) Silver(40) Bronze(20)
- 2) The total score is added up both the score of overall results of the team in each division and the total medal score from the individuals who does not participate in the team competition. When the total score is in a tie, the number of competitors will be a criterion.
 Gold Medal 80pts, Silver Medal 40pts, Bronze Medal 20pts, the number of participants

- Tournament of 4 competitors for each division.
- The list of match shall be determined according to the comparison on participants' physical conditions at the venue on the competition day of the match.
- Competition: 1 minute x 2 rounds
- A tournament can be integrated when the number of competitors in each division(years or belts) is less than 4.
- Only foreign players are allowed to participate. However, you can participate in the B League if you want.

- Method of Competitions: The cut-off system shall be applied. (But in case of an insufficient number of competitors in each division, single elimination tournament system shall be applied).
 - Qualifiers: Contestants shall perform one of compulsory Poomsae, compulsory Poomsae shall be decided by draw lots, and top 50% of the contestants will be selected. (Qualifiers can be divided into two sections depending on the number of participants).
 - Qualifying Round: Contestants shall perform one of the compulsory poomsae, the top 8 scorers advance to the finals.
 - Finals: Contestants shall perform a compulsory Poomsae, thereby the 1st, 2nd, 3rd place will be decided.
 - Qualifiers: Draw lots of a compulsory Poomsae shall be conducted during the representatives' meeting.
- Duration of competition: within 90 seconds (Exceeding the time, deduction shall be applied).
- Scoring Method: WT Poomsae rules followed.

- Individual: Tournament system shall be applied (Four participants in a group).
- Pair, Trio Team Division: Tournament system shall be applied (4 teams in a group).
- ※ In case of an insufficient number of participants in each division, integration of divisions shall be applied

○ Duration of the performance: within 90 seconds (Exceeding the time, deduction shall be applied)

○ Scoring Method: KTA Poomsae rules followed.

○ Daejeon MBC Broadcast: The 1st place winner from each division may participate in the match of the winners (King of Kings)

- Qualification: Poom or Dan holder certified by Kukkiwon, Recommendation of masters/coaches is needed for the non-Korean athletes.

- * A criterion on the division of Free Style Poomsae Individual and Pair Competition is alike
- Freestyle Poomsae: a performance based on Taekwondo techniques with composition of music and choreography.
- Music & Choreography: Participants shall organize freely.
 - ※ Music can be chosen freely, but religious, violent or abusive musics are strictly prohibited.
 - ※ Please be careful not to be disadvantaged by poor sound quality when a competition is held in online.

If there is still a draw, the decision will be based on the rules of the World Taekwondo Federation.
